Gravely concerned over increase land violation from power brokers

Joint Statement

PHNOM PENH, 14 December, 2011: Advocacy Team of Associations and NGOs Non-Government Organization (“AT”) has 39 members of Associations and NGOs would like to express for “Gravely concerned over increase land violation from power brokers” who had position in Senate, National Assembly, Government, and Court institutions.

The report of Advocacy Team of Associations and NGOs observed that land violation had over increase in the last 11 months, 2011. Thousand Cambodian’s families and thousands of people were suffered by lost lands and households, without habitats and they were brutally beaten by authorities with supported from power brokers. These obscure actions were opposite Cambodian’s Constitution and Universal Human Rights.

The observation showed that the destroy, burn and chase from habitats were happened around 24 capitals-provinces of Cambodia, without any institutions including Senate, National Assembly, Government, and Court institutions had encouraged to solve or obstructed these cases. In parallel, we observed that a big issue was happened in Phnom Penh City at Boeung Kok area, recently. Thousands of Cambodian’s people were suffered, had a bad spirit, got lost audacious and were afraid on the second time after Khmer Rouge regime.

During 11 months, we observed that without persons or power brokers and beaters were prisoned and revoked positions. Even if, the decree was issued by Government, it still had not available. These issues were expressed by National and International statements, especially Civil Society Organizations and International Communities to suggest to Government to solve and stop all cases immediately. Do cases will have continued or stopped?
